REGULATIONS UNDER THE ELECTORAL ACT 1965-1970

Pursuant to Section 27A of the Electoral Act 1965-1970 the Cabinet hereby makes the following Regulations -

ELECTORAL (BY-ELECTION) REGULATIONS

CITATION

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral (By-Election) Regulations.

COMMENCING DATE

- 2. These Regulations shall come into operation upon a date to be fixed by Cabinet, by notice in the Gazette.

DETERMINATION OF RESULT OF BY-ELECTION

When in any Constituency an election is held for the purpose of electing one member of Parliament only for that Constituency consequent upon the death retirement or disqualification of a member then in that situation only the method of determining the result of an election set forth in Section 27 Sub-sections (1) (2) (3) and (5) of the Electoral Act 1965-1970 shall be followed.
