## CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

### APPOINTMENT OF CABINET UNDERT ARTICLE 21

## CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

### ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT
