### THE DISTRICT COURT

- 1. As from 24th February, 1992 all complaints or charges received will be given dates for hearing and listed in a Fixation Diary as soon as they are received.
- 2. The Lists will start on Monday 27th March. Un+il then the Court will deal with the present backlog of cases.
  - 3. The Court will be available to sit each day in each week except during Supreme Court Sessions as stated below as follows.
    - a) On Mondays the Court List will be confined to cases relating to Charges under the Motor Traffic Act.
    - b) On <u>Tuesdays</u> Charges, other than Motor Traffic Act Charges will be listed.
    - c) On Wednesdays Charges other than Motor Traffic Charges.
    - d) On <u>Thursdays</u> On one Thursday in each month Juvenile cases will be listed and dealt with.

On the remaining three Thursdays the Court will be free to deal with any defended or other matters (such as Preliminary Inquiries) not able to be dealt with on the first three days of the week.

e) On Fridays

Family Court will sit on the First Friday in each Month. On the other 3 Fridays the Court will be available to deal with outstanding matters. Preliminary Inquiries commenced on Thursdays and not completed on that day will be continued on this day.

- 4. Unless there are insufficient cases for listing, there must be at least 25 new cases set down for hearing on each Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday in addition to any cases adjourned to each respective day.
- 5. The practice of adjourning cases for "Mention Only" will cease. Adjournment will be granted for substantive hearings only.
- 6. Court Lists will be prepared and served on Police and other Complainants at least five (5) days before the dates set for hearing. For the Criminal Record Book; the cases for hearing will be given to Lumen who will be responsible for entering them in the Book.
- 7. Summons to Defendants will be handed to the Police for service at least four (4) days before the hearing date of their cases.
- 8. A Diary will be provided for the purpose of recording the cases listed
- 9. The Clerk of the Court shall determine the procedure necessary to implement the above directions and will be responsible for their administration.

#### SUPREME COURT SESSIONS

- 10. During the Sessions of the Supreme Court the above procedures will be varied:
- 11. The Chief Justice will hold four (4) Sessions of the Supreme Court each year of at least 4 weeks duration each.
- 12. During each Session the sittings of the District Court shall be confined to Chambers matters and five (5) days of ordinary sittings. The dates for these latter sittings will be fixed prior to the Sessions.

- 13. Ten (10) days before the Sessions of the Supreme Court commence, the Director of Public Prosecutions, the Prosecution Branch of the Police and all the Nauru Lands Committee parties (including counsel and/or pleaders) will be notified of the date of the commencement of the Sessions and asked to set down any matters for hearing within 5 days of the commencement of the Sessions. All matters desired to be heard will be then set down together with those which have already been adjourned for the Sessions. Lists of hearing's will be prepared and given to the above.
- 14. Notice of the Sessions will also be notified in the Nauru Gazette in the usual manner.
- 15. The Registrar will set 3 days of the Sessions days for Land Appeals. It is realised that the desire for fixture in these are difficult to ascertain in advance and there will be flexibility in setting down of these appeals. They may be set down at any time.
- 16. The remaining Sessions for 1992 of the Supreme Court (unless otherwise change by the Chief Justice) will commence as follows:

Tuesday 19th May, 1992 Tuesday 18th August, 1992 Tuesday 17th November, 1992

Sessions should be scheduled for four (4) weeks. Apart from the 5 days scheduled for the District Court, the Supreme Court will be available to sit daily and will deal with interlocutory and /or Chambers matters on any day.
