#### DIRECTIONS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY

#### (SITTING OF PARLIAMENT)

**PURSUANT** to the powers vested in me under Regulation 23, **I**, **Lionel Rouwen Aingimea**, **M.P.**, Minister for National Emergency Services, do hereby issue these **DIRECTIONS** for the purpose of easing the previous restrictions put in place to manage and minimise the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), commencing from 12.00am on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022 until it is revoked:

A Member of Parliament attending a sitting of Parliament:

- (a) shall maintain a sitting distance of 1.5 meters from another Member in the Chamber of the Parliament during the sitting;
- (b) may wear a mask at all times except during any period he or she is speaking;
- (c) shall have undergone a Rapid Antigen Test which produces a negative result for coronavirus (COVID-19) before the commencement of the sitting; and
- (d) shall follow and maintain the guidelines for maintaining cleanliness or hygiene including using sanitisers as and when necessary.
