

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 1950-51.⁽¹⁾

No. 34 of 1950.

An Ordinance to grant and apply out of the Public Revenue a sum for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and to appropriate the supplies granted for that year.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua and New Guinea Act 1949* as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the *Appropriation Ordinance 1950-51.*⁽¹⁾

Grant of £3,340,200. **2.** Subject to authorization from the Administrator, the Treasurer may issue out of the Public Revenue and apply for the service of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, the sum of Three million three hundred and forty thousand two hundred pounds.

Appropriation. **3.** All sums granted by this Ordinance and the other Ordinances mentioned in the First Schedule to this Ordinance out of the Public Revenue for the service of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, amounting as appears by that Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Six million six hundred and seventy-nine thousand two hundred pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.
