CORPORATE BODIES (JOINT TENANCY) ORDINANCE 1951.(1)

No. 33 of 1951.

An Ordinance to enable Bodies Corporate to hold Property in Joint Tenancy.

B E it ordained by the Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949-1950, as follows:---

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bodies Corporate (Joint short title. Tenancy) Ordinance 1951.(1)
- 2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be commencement. fixed by the Administrator by notice⁽¹⁾ in the Gazette.
- 3. The Bodies Corporate (Joint Tenancy) Ordinance, 1928(2) Repeal. of the Territory of Papua is repealed.
- 4.—(1.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-section, a body Power for corporate is capable of acquiring and holding any real or personal corporations to hold property in joint tenancy in the same manner as if it were an property as joint tenants, individual, and where a body corporate and an individual or two or more bodies corporate become entitled to any real or personal property under circumstances or by virtue of an instrument, which would if the body corporate had been an individual have created a joint tenancy, they are entitled to the property as joint tenants.

- (2.) The acquisition and holding of property by a body corporate in joint tenancy is subject to the like conditions and restrictions as attach to the acquisition and holding of property by a body corporate in severalty.
- 5. Where a body corporate is joint tenant of any property pevolution of then on its dissolution the property devolves on the other joint property on dissolution of tenant.
