DANGEROUS DRUGS (PAPUA) ORDINANCE 1950.(1)

No. 31 of 1950.

An Ordinance to amend the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1923 of the Territory of Papua.

BE it enacted by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Dangerous Drugs* (*Papua*) Ordinance 1950.⁽¹⁾

- (2.) The Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1923⁽²⁾ of the Territory of Papua is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Dangerous Drugs Ordinance* 1923–1950.
 - 2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Definitions.

- (a) by omitting from the definition of "Dangerous Drugs" the word "and" (fourth occurring); and
- (b) by adding at the end of that definition the following word and paragraph:—

"; and

Any other narcotic drug which the Administrator by notice⁽³⁾ in the *Gazette* declares to be a dangerous drug."

3. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended—

First Schedule

- (a) by omitting from sub-paragraph (e) the words "Cocaine, and" and inserting in their stead the word "Cocaine."; and
- (b) by inserting after sub-paragraph (f) the following word and sub-paragraph:—
 - "; and (g) Any other narcotic drug which the Administrator by notice⁽³⁾ in the *Gazette* declares to be a dangerous drug."
- 4. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (i) of the definition of "Dangerous Drug" the following sub-paragraph;—

Second Schedule.

"(j) Any other narcotic drug which the Administrator by notice⁽³⁾ in the *Gazette* declares to be a dangerous drug."
