## DOG (PAPUA) ORDINANCE 1950.(1)

#### No. 23 of 1950.

# An Ordinance to amend the Dog Ordinance 1913 of the Territory of Papua.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949, as follows:—

## Sher title and estation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be eited as the *Dog (Papua)* Ordinance 1950.<sup>(1)</sup>
- (2.) The *Dog Ordinance*, 1913<sup>(2)</sup> of the Territory of Papua is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Dog Ordinance* 1913-1950.

### Dog (Papua) Ordinance 1950-cont.

2. Section six of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (2) the following sub-paragraph:—

Districts and Regulations.

" (da) prohibiting the presence of dogs in any area declared by the Administrator by notice (3) in the Gazette to be an area set aside for bathing, authorizing the seizure and sale or destruction of any dogs found in any such area, and imposing a penalty (not exceeding the penalty specified in the next succeeding subparagraph) on the owner of any dog found in any such area; and ".
