## AMENDMENT OF DOG REGULATIONS.(1)

## Regulations.

## No. 5 of 1951.

- 1. The Dog Regulations of the Territory of Papua are amended by inserting immediately after Regulation 1 thereof the following new Regulation:—
  - "1A. These Regulations may be cited as the Dog Regulations."
- 2. The Dog Regulations are further amended by inserting after Regulation 21 thereof the following new Regulations:—
- "22. The Administrator may, by notice (2) in the Gazette, declare any area to be an area set aside for bathing.
- 23.—(1.) No person shall bring any dog into any area declared by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette to be an area set aside for bathing.

(2.) Any person contravening the provisions of the preceding sub-regulation shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding Ten pounds (£10).

## PART B: ANIMALS AND BIRDS-

24. Any dog found in any area declared by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette to be an area set aside for bathing may be seized by any Member of the Royal Papuan Constabulary or its successor, and sold and if no sale of any dog seized under the provisions of this regulation can be effected within three days, the dog may be destroyed."
