EXPLOSIVES (NEW GUINEA) ORDINANCE 1950.(1)

No. 44 of 1950.

An Ordinance to bring into Operation the Explosives (New Guinea) Ordinance 1949 of the Territory of Papua-New Guinea.

E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Explosives (New Guinea) short title. Ordinance 1950. (1)
- 2. The Explosives (New Guinea) Ordinance 1949(2) of the Explosives Territory of Papua-New Guinea shall, by force of this Ordinance, be deemed to have taken effect from the first day of July, One deemed to be in force and thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and to be, and at all times operation. on and after that date to have been, in force and in operation in relation to the Territory of New Guinea.

TERRITORY OF PAPUA AND NEW GUINEA.

Explosives Ordinance 1928-1949 of the Territory of New Guinea.

DELEGATION.

WHEREAS by section 7 of the Exposives Ordinance 1928-1949 of the Territory of New Guinea it is provided that the Administrator may by writing under his hand delegate to any person all or any of his powers under the said Ordinance so that the delegated powers and functions may be exercised by the delegate with regard to the matters or class of matters specified in the Instrument of Delegation:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, the Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the said section and all other powers me enabling, do hereby delegate to the Officers for the time being administering the Districts named in the Schedule hereto the powers under section 18 of the said Ordinance to grant to any person a special permit to use explosives for the purpose of removing earth or rock for agricultural or excavation purposes, the purpose of clearing land used or to be used for agriculture, and the purpose of roadmaking and repair.
