Sertion 55 (1) of the Ordinances Interpretation Ordinance 1949-1950 provides that a reference in an Ordinance of the Territory of New Guinea to "the New Guinea Gazette" shall be read as a reference to the Government Gazette of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea.
At the relevant dates in 1950 there was no Ordinance or regulation of general application providing for the meaning of "forthwith".
