Prisons Ordinance, 1919-1930, of the Territory of Papua.

DECLARATION OF PRISON AND PENAL DISTRICT.

I JACK KEITH MURRAY, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 19 of the *Prisons Ordinance, 1919-1930, of the Territory of Papua* and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare the building and premises erected after the commencement of the said Ordinance referred to in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto, to be a Prison under the said Ordinance:

And I further declare, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 20 of the said Ordinance the area specified in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto surrounding such Prison, to be a Penal District under the said Ordinance.

THE SCHEDULE.

PART 1.

GEHUA-MILNE BAY PRISON.

Buildings and premises now used or to be used for the purposes of imprisonment at Gehua-Milne Bay.

PART 2.

GEHUA-MILNE BAY PENAL DISTRICT.

The area surrounding Gehua-Milne Bay Prison contained within the limits of the Gehua-Milne Bay Government Station.

PROCLAMATION

Prisons Ordinance, 1919-1930, of the Territory of Papua.

DECLARATION OF PRISON AND PENAL DISTRICT.

I JACK KEITH MURRAY, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 19 of the *Prisons Ordinance, 1919-1930, of the Territory of Papua* and all other powers me enabling, do hereby proclaim and declare the buildings and premises erected after the commencement of the said Ordinance, referred to in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto, to be a Prison under the said Ordinance:

And by virtue of the powers conferred by section 20 of the said Ordinance, I do further hereby proclaim and declare the area specified in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto surrounding such Prison, to be a Penal District under the said Ordinance.

PART 1.

POPONDETTA PRISON.

Buildings and premises now used or to be used for the purposes of imprisonment situated at Popondetta.

PART 2.

POPONDETTA PENAL DISTRICT.

The area surrounding Popondetta Prison contained within the limits of Popondetta Government Station.

Given under my Hand at Port Moresby, this twentieth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in the fifteenth year of His Majesty's reign.
