#### Prices Regulation Ordinance 1949.

### DECLARATION OF GOODS.

I, JACK KEITH MURRAY, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 21 of the *Prices Regulation Ordinance* 1949 and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare that the goods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be declared goods for the purposes of the said Ordinance.

#### THE SCHEDULE.

#### DECLARED GOODS.

Aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, fountain drinks, cordials, fruit juices and fruit syrups.

Biscuits, excepting dog biscuits.

Bread.

Butter.

Canned foodstuffs intended for human consumption which consist wholly or partly of meat.

Candles.

Cheese and cheese spreads.

Coffee, with or without chicory; coffee beans.

Coffee essences.

Cocoa.

Chocolate and chocolates.

Cocoa butter.

Cream, fresh or in tins.

Eggs in shell and egg contents in powder or liquid form.

Fats, edible.

Fish, canned.

Flour, wheaten; wheatmeal and self-raising flour.

Foods primarily for breakfast use prepared from wheat, maize, oats or rice whether in granulated, flaked, biscuit or any other form, including oatmeals of all types but not including cornflour.

Fruits, canned or preserved, excepting crystallized fruits.

Glucose. Golden syrup.

Grains, namely wheat, barley and oats.

Honey.

Ice-cream and ice-cream mixtures.

Infants' and invalids' foods.

Jams and jellies.

Malt and malt extracts.

Margarine.

Matches.

Meat, fresh, chilled or frozen, namely-

(a) Beef and mutton, including veal and hoggett.

(b) Offal meat.

(c) Sausages and sausage meat.

THE SCHEDULE—continued.

Meats, canned. Meats, fancy. Methylated spirits. Milk. Milk, dried or in powder form, condensed or malted. Onions. Pickles and chutneys. Potatoes. Rice, including ground rice. Salt. Sauces. Soap, including soap extracts, flakes, powders, cakes and tablets. Soap substitutes and compounded detergents for washing and cleansing purposes. Soup, canned. Spaghetti, canned. Starch. Sugar of all kinds. Tea. Treacle. Tomato juice. Vegetables, canned. Vinegar. Yeast.
