# AMENDMENT OF THE POSTAGE, TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH RATES REGULATIONS, 1951.(1)(2)

### Regulations.

### No. 22 of 1951.

- 1. The Postage, Telephone and Telegraph Rates Regulations, 1951, (3) of the Territory of New Guinea are amended by repealing Regulation 17 thereof and inserting in its stead the following new Regulation:—
- "17. The rates of commission chargeable for the issue of Money Money Orders. Orders shall be:—
  - (a) A Money Order payable in the Territory or in Papua, 1s. for the first £5 or fraction of £5 and 6d. for each additional £5 or fraction of £5;
  - (b) For Money Orders payable in the Commonwealth of Australia, Nauru, New Caledonia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island or Fiji, 4d. for each £1 or fraction thereof with a minimum of 1s.; and
  - (c) For Money Orders payable elsewhere, 6d. for each £1 or fraction of £1 for the first £6, and 4d. for each additional £1 or fraction thereof with a minimum of 1s."

#### FIRST SCHEDULE-continued.

#### NEWSPAPERS-BULK RATE.

For newspapers registered for transmission as such (without condition as to the number contained in each addressed wrapper) posted by-

(a) The Proprietor thereof to bona fide subscribers and to newsvendors and agents for the purpose of sale; and

(b) Newsvendors and agents to bona fide subscribers and to other newsvendors and agents for the purpose of sale:—
2½d. for each 8 oz. or part of 8 oz. on the aggregate weight of

the newspapers posted at one time. Maximum weight 28 lb. per package.

The rate of postage on bulk postings of newspapers for delivery within the Territory of New Guinea applies also to bulk postings for delivery in Lord Howe Island, Norfolk Island, Nauru, the Commonwealth of Australia and Papua.

For newspapers registered for transmission as such posted by the proprietors thereof or by newsvendors or agents to bona fide subscribers or to newsvendors or agents for the purpose of sale (in consignments of not fewer than four newspapers of the same issue):—

2½d. for each 8 oz. or part of 8 oz. on the aggregate weight of the newspapers posted at the one time.

#### DEFENCE FORCES.

The rates of postage for mail to or from Members of the Defence Forces shall be those set out in Special Supplement (No. 4) of October, 1944, to the Commonwealth Post Office Guide.
