The Royal Papuan Constabulary Regulations (2) are amended by deleting the First Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the following Schedule:-

At the relevant dates in 1950, the Royal Papuan Constabulary Ordinance, 1939-1940 (under which these Regulations were made) made no provision as to the date of commencement of regulations made thereunder, but Section 37 (1) of the Ordinances Interpretation Ordinance 1949 of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea provided that "Regulations made under an Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears in the Ordinance—

(a) shall be published in the Gazette; and

(b) shall . take effect from the date of publication, or where another date is specified in the regulations from the date specified."

At the relevant dates in 1950, there was no Ordinance or regulation of general application providing for the meaning of "forthwith".
