# SUPERANNUATION REGULATIONS.

## Regulations.

## No. 24 of 1951.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Superannuation Regula- Citation. tions. (1)
- 2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears, "the Definition. Ordinance" means the Superannuation (Papua and New Guinea) Ordinances 1951. (2)
- 3.—(1.) A former State employee who elects to contribute to the Rightsland Fund in accordance with Part VIII. of the Ordinance shall, as from the commencement of the Ordinance—

  Rightsland obligations of former State employees employees employees employees electing to
  - (a) relinquish the rights to superannuation benefits which were agreed upon under the terms of his employment by the Provisional Administration or the Administration, and shall receive, in lieu thereof, such units of pension under the Ordinance as are specified opposite to his name in the second column of the Schedule to these regulations; and
  - (b) contribute to the Fund—(i) the amount which he was contributed
    - (i) the amount which he was contributing in respect of his relinquished rights immediately before the commencement of the Ordinance; and
    - (ii) the amount prescribed by the Ordinance in respect of such number of units as represents the difference between the units appropriate to his salary-group specified in the First Schedule to the Ordinance and the number of units specified opposite to his name in the second column of the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2.) Where the salary of a former State employee referred to in the last preceding sub-regulation is increased and, by reason of the increase, falls within a higher salary-group, he shall pay additional contributions as prescribed by the Ordinance.
- (3.) A former State employee to whom this regulation applies and who was over the age of forty years at the commencement of the Ordinance, may, in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-six of the Ordinance, elect to contribute to the Fund for a smaller number of

additional units than the number of units referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1.) of this regulation, or sub-regulation (2.) of this regulation, as the case may be.

(4.) For the purposes of sub-regulation (1.) of this regulation, a unit of pension shall be in accordance with section thirty-nine of the Ordinance.
