SEA-CARRIAGE OF GOODS (PAPUA) ORDINANCE 1950.(1)(2)

No. 46 of 1950.

An Ordinance to make Provision for bringing into Operation the Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance, 1939 of the Territory of Papua.

B^E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Sea-Carriage of Goods (Papua) Ordinance 1950. (1)
- (2.) The Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance, 1939⁽²⁾ of the Territory of Papua, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance 1939–1950.

Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance 1939 to be in force. 2.—(1.) The Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance 1939⁽³⁾ of the Territory of Papua shall, by force of this Ordinance but subject to the next succeeding sub-section, be deemed to be in force in the Territory of Papua.

- (2.) The provisions of the Ordinance referred to in the last preceding sub-section shall not operate until the date fixed under section two of that Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.
- 3. Section two of the Sea-Carriage of Goods Ordinance, 1939(2) commencement of the Territory of Papua is amended by omitting the words "the of operation." Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation published" and inserting in their stead the words "the Administrator by notice".
