PART C: POST AND TELEGRAPH-

AMENDMENT OF TELEGRAPHIC ADDRESSES REGULATIONS 1919.⁽¹⁾

Regulations.

No. 28 of 1951.

1. Regulation 2 of the *Telegraphic Addresses Regulations* $1919^{(2)}$ is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (a) thereof and inserting in its stead the following new sub-paragraph:—

"(a) Code or abbreviated names to be used with telegraphic addresses may be registered with the Chief Postmaster upon payment of the prescribed fee."

2. Regulation 2 of the *Telegraphic Addresses Regulations* $1919^{(2)}$ is further amended by deleting sub-paragraph (c) thereof and inserting in its stead the following new sub-paragraph:—

"(c) Fees payable in respect of each code or abbreviated address so registered shall be as follows:----

(i) An annual fee of £3 3s.; or

(ii) A monthly fee of 7s. 6d."

3. The *Telegraphic Addresses Regulations* $1919^{(2)}$ are further amended by deleting Regulations 3, 4 and 5 thereof.
