Volcanic and Seismic Disturbances Ordinance 1951.

DECLARATION OF VOLCANIC AREA.

Whereas by section 3 of the Volcanic and Seismic Disturbances Ordinance 1951, it is among other things provided that the Administrator, where he is of the opinion that a part of the Territory is the subject of a volcanic or seismic disturbance, may by Proclamation in the Gazette declare that part of the Territory to be a volcanic area:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, being of the opinion that the Mount Lamington Area in the Northern Division of the Territory of Papua is the subject of a volcanic disturbance, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 3 of the said Ordinance and all other powers me enabling, do hereby declare the area within a ten-mile radius of the crater of the Mount Lamington Volcano in the said Northern Division to be a Volcanic Area to be known as the Mount Lamington Volcanic Area.

Given under my Hand at Port Moresby, this eighth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in the fifteenth year of His Majesty's reign.
