Post-Graduate Legal Training (Amendment) Act 1992,

Being an Act to amend the *Post-Graduate Legal Training Act* (Chapter 168),
MADE by the National Parliament.

ADMISSION TO THE INSTITUTE (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 16).

Section 16(2) of the Principal Act is repealed and is replaced with the following:-

- "(2) A candidate for admission shall not be admitted to the Institute as a trainee unless -
- (a) he is, in the opinion of the Council, a fit and proper person; and
 - (b) he has spent a period of, or periods totalling, not less than 12 months in the field -
 - (i) studying customary laws and practices; or
 - (ii) carrying out work involving customary laws and practices; or
 - (iii) carrying out community work of a legal nature,under the supervision of the Dean of the Faculty of Law of the University of Papua New Guinea or a person appointed by him for the purposes."
