# ORDINANCES REPRINT AND REVISION ORDINANCE 1947. (1) (2)

### No. 16 of 1947.

An Ordinance to provide for the Consolidation, Revision and Re-printing of the Ordinances and Subordinate Legislation of the Territory of Papua and the Territory of New Guinea.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua-New Guinea Provisional Administration Act 1945-1946, as follows:—

#### PART I.—PRELIMINARY.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Ordinances Reprint and Short title. Revision Ordinance 1947. (1) (2)
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation commencement on the date of commencement of the Papua-New Guinea Provisional Administration Act 1945. (3)
  - 3. This Ordinance is divided into Parts, as follows:—

Part I.—Preliminary.

Part II.—The Annotated Reprints.

Part III.—Amendment and Repeal of Ordinances, Regulations and Rules of Court.

Definitions.

- 4. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears—
  "Administrator"—
  - (a) in relation to the Territory of New Guinea, means the Administrator of that Territory;
  - (b) in relation to the Territory of Papua, means the Administrator of that Territory; and
  - (c) in relation to the Possession of British New Guinea, means the Administrator of that Possession;
  - "an Administration Printer" means any person printing for the Administration of the Territory of Papua-New Guinea: (4)

### "Lieutenant-Governor"

- (a) in relation to the Territory of Papua, means the the (5) Lieutenant-Governor of that Territory; and
- (b) in relation to the Possession of British New Guinea, means the Lieutenant-Governor of that Possession;
- "Ordinance" includes any Act (not being an Act of the Parliament of the Commonwealth) or Ordinance adopted as a law of, or applied to, or continued in force in, the Territory of New Guinea or the Territory of Papua, respectively;
- "subordinate legislation" includes regulations, rules of court, standing orders, by-laws, orders in council, proclamations, orders and notices of the Territory of New Guinea and the Territory of Papua, respectively, whether any such instrument is of a legislative character or not, and includes any such instrument (not being an instrument made under an Act of the Parliament of the Commonwealth) adopted as a law of, or applied to, or continued in force in, the Territory of New Guinea or the Territory of Papua, respectively;
- "the Annotated Reprints" means the Annotated Reprints authorized by section five of this Ordinance to be printed and published.

### PART II.—THE ANNOTATED REPRINTS.

5. Annotated Reprints of the Ordinances and subordinate legislation of the Territory of New Guinea and the Territory of Papua, respectively, other than Appropriation and Supply Ordinances and Ordinances and subordinate legislation which relate solely to the repeal of prior legislation, which were in force in the respective Territories on the twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, may be printed and published, by direction of the Minister of State for External Territories, by an Administration Printer, under the respective titles of "The Laws of the Territory of New Guinea, 1921-1945 (Annotated)" and "The Laws of the Territory of Papua, 1888-1945 (Annotated)".

Annotated prepared and published.

6. In the Ordinances and subordinate legislation reprinted in Correction of the Annotated Reprints-

minor errors in Reprints

- (a) if any section, or any sub-section or paragraph of any section, of any Ordinance, or any regulation, subregulation, rule, sub-rule or paragraph of any subordinate legislation, is incorrectly numbered or lettered, or has no number or reference letter, the number or reference letter may be corrected or deleted, or a number or reference letter may be added, as the case requires;
- (b) any error in spelling in any Ordinance or subordinate legislation may be corrected, and capital letters may be changed to small letters or small letters may be changed to capital letters, as the case requires, for the purpose of ensuring uniformity:
- (c) any error in punctuation in any Ordinance or subordinate legislation may be corrected, and any alterations in punctuation necessitated by reason of an amendment having been made to any Ordinance or subordinate legislation may be made; and
- (d) if any Ordinance or any section of any Ordinance, or any Regulations or any regulation of any Regulations, or any Rules of Court or any rule of any Rules of Court, is or are numbered with Roman numerals, those Roman numerals may be changed to the corresponding Arabic numbers; and if in any Ordinance or subordinate legislation there is any reference to the Roman numerals of any Ordinance or section of any Ordinance, or of any Regulations or regulation of any Regulations, or of any Rules of Court or rule

of any Rules of Court, the Roman numerals appearing in the Ordinance or subordinate legislation may be changed to the corresponding Arabic numbers.

Text of Ordinances, &c., in Annotated Reprints to be prima facie evidence.

- 7.—(1.) Unless the contrary is shewn, it shall be presumed that the text of any Ordinance or of any subordinate legislation reprinted in the Annotated Reprints correctly sets forth the text of that Ordinance or that subordinate legislation and any amendments thereof, as at the twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
- (2.) The dates appearing in the footnotes to any Ordinance, and purporting to be the respective dates on which that Ordinance and the Ordinances amending that Ordinance were respectively made by the Governor-General in Council, or were made, assented to or reserved by the Administrator or Lieutenant-Governor, or took effect or came into operation, or on which the assent of the Governor-General was published in the New Guinea Gazette or the Government Gazette of the Territory of Papua, or on which those Ordinances were notified in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette, shall be evidence that those dates were the dates on which that Ordinance and the Ordinances amending that Ordinance were respectively made by the Governor-General in Council, or were made, assented to or reserved by the Administrator or Lieutenant-Governor, or took effect or came into operation, or on which the assent of the Governor-General was published in the New Guinea Gazette or the Government Gazette of the Territory of Papua, or on which those Ordinances were notified in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette, as the case may be.
- (3.) The dates appearing in the footnotes to any subordinate legislation, and purporting to be the respective dates on which that subordinate legislation and the subordinate legislation amending that subordinate legislation were respectively made, published in the New Guinea Gazette or the Government Gazette of the Territory of Papua or the Government Gazette of the Possession of British New Guinea, and took effect or came into operation, or took effect and came into operation, shall be evidence that those dates were the dates on which that subordinate legislation and the subordinate legislation amending that subordinate legislation were respectively made, published in the New Guinea Gazette or the Government Gazette of the Territory of Papua or the Government Gazette of the Possession of British New Guinea, and took effect or came into operation, or took effect and came into operation, as the case may be.

8.—(1.) All courts and persons acting judicially shall take Judicial notice judicial notice of the text of the Ordinances and subordinate Reprints. legislation reprinted in the Annotated Reprints.

- (2.) Subject to section seven of this Ordinance, no annotation to any Ordinance or to any subordinate legislation, no crossreference, and no explanatory matter preceding any Ordinance or any subordinate legislation shall be deemed part thereof or be judicially noticed.
- (3.) The mere production of a volume purporting to be a volume of "The Laws of the Territory of New Guinea, 1921-1945 (Annotated)" or of "The Laws of the Territory of Papua, 1888-1945 (Annotated)" and to have been printed by an Administration Printer shall in all courts and before all persons acting judicially be evidence that the volume is a volume of "The Laws of the Territory of New Guinea, 1921-1945 (Annotated)" or of "The Laws of the Territory of Papua, 1888-1945 (Annotated)", as the case may be.

# PART III.—AMENDMENT AND REPEAL OF ORDINANCES,

REGULATIONS AND RULES OF COURT.

9. The Ordinances of the Territory of New Guinea specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.

Amendment of Ordinances of the Territory

10. The Ordinances of the Territory of Papua specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.

Amendment of the Territory of Papua.

11.—(1.) All Ordinances of the Possession of British New Guinea, and all Ordinances of the Territory of Papua numbered before Ordinance No. 2 of 1920, shall be deemed always to have been numbered with Arabic numbers corresponding to the Roman numerals assigned to them, and shall be known and cited by those Arabic numbers for all purposes.

Renumbering of the Possession of British New Guinea and the Territory of Papua.

(2.) All sections of Ordinances of the Possession of British New Guinea, and all sections of Ordinances of the Territory of Papua made before Ordinance No. 1 of 1907, shall be deemed always to have been numbered with Arabic numbers corresponding to the Roman numerals assigned to them.

Amendment of Regulations and Rules of Court of the Territory of New Guinea.

- 12.—(1.) The Regulations and Rules of Court of the Territory of New Guinea specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.
- (2.) Any Regulations or Rules of Court, which have been amended in the manner specified in the second column of the Third Schedule to this Ordinance may be repealed or further amended in pursuance of the powers under which those Regulations or Rules of Court might have been repealed immediately before the date of commencement of this Ordinance or, if those powers are amended at a date after the date of commencement of this Ordinance, in pursuance of those powers as so amended.

Amendment of Regulations and Rules of Court of the Territory of Papua.

- 13.—(1.) The Regulations and Rules of Court of the Territory of Papua specified in the first column of the Fourth Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.
- (2.) Any Regulations or Rules of Court, which have been amended in the manner specified in the second column of the Fourth Schedule to this Ordinance may be repealed or further amended in pursuance of the powers under which those Regulations or Rules of Court might have been repealed immediately before the date of commencement of this Ordinance or, if those powers are amended at a date after the date of commencement of this Ordinance, in pursuance of those powers as so amended.

Repeal of Ordinances of the Territory of New Guinea.

14. The Ordinances of the Territory of New Guinea specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Ordinance are repealed.

Repeal of Ordinances of the Territory of Papua. 15. The Ordinances of the Territory of Papua specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Ordinance are repealed.

Citation of Queensland Acts adopted in Territory of Papua.

- 16.—(1.) Each adopted Act of the State of Queensland specified in the first column of the Seventh Schedule to this Ordinance may, in its application to the Territory of Papua, be cited, without prejudice to any other mode of citation, in the manner specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to the reference to that Act in the first column of that Schedule.
- (2.) Where any Regulations or Rules of Court of the Territory of New Guinea or the Territory of Papua do not prescribe a mode by which those Regulations or Rules of Court may be cited, those Regulations or Rules of Court may, without prejudice to any other mode of citation, be cited by reference to the headings respectively assigned to them in the Annotated Reprints.
