AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY SEVEN MILLION, ONE HUNDRED AND TWO THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY TWO DOLLARS, TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER 2012.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

2012 SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT 2012

Short title and 1. This Act may be cited as the 2012 Supplementary commencement Appropriation Act 2012 and commences on the date ("commencement date") of assent. Authorisation and The issue from the Consolidated Fund is 2. (1)appropriation of \$247,102,782 hereby authorised of a sum of two hundred and forty seven million, one hundred and two thousand, seven hundred and eighty two dollars, to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 2012. The sum specified in subsection (1) shall be deemed to have (2)been appropriated as from the commencement date for the supply of the heads and in the amounts respectively specified for such heads, as set out in the Schedule. Contingencies 3. The Minister may, from the commencement date warrants until 31st December 2012, and pursuant to section 15 of the Public

Finance and Audit Act (Cap. 120) -

 (a) for the Heads of Recurrent Expenditure, authorise under contingencies warrants such sums not exceeding fifteen million dollars; and

(b) for the Heads of Development Expenditure, authorise under contingencies warrants such sums not exceeding five million dollars.

Overdrafts and advances

4. The Government may, at any time or times not later than the 31st December 2012, borrow by way of overdraft and advances within or outside Solomon Islands, any sum not exceeding in the whole one hundred and fifty million dollars on such terms and conditions as the Minister may approve.

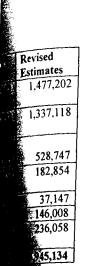

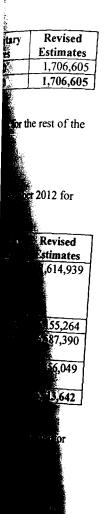

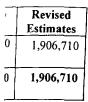
