EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS 2022

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (REVOCATION) (NO. 3) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 18 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2022* (Legal Notice No. 112 of 2022), and with reference to sections 36(a) and 65(2) of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

1 Citation
