EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (No. 3) REGULATIONS 2021 EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (EXTENSION OF QUARANTINE) (No. 2) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, the Prime Minister, under regulation 36(1) (b) of *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), being satisfied that it is necessary to do so to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 within Solomon Islands, make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Extension of Quarantine) (No. 2) Order 2022.*

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Extension of quarantine

The quarantine period of each person specified in the Schedule, who entered Solomon Islands on 24 December 2021, is extended from 7 January 2022 for 2 more days ending on 9 January 2022, and they each must be quarantined at a quarantine station during that 2-day period.

4 Testing of person

Each person whose quarantine is extended under paragraph 3 must be tested for the presence of COVID-19 on 9 January 2022, and must test negative for COVID-19 for the test.
