PRISONS ACT (Cap. 111)

THE PRISONS (VISITING CONTINGENT) REGULATIONS 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 61 of the Prisons Act, I, SIR. ALLAN KEMAKEZA, Knight of the British Empire and Prime Minister of Solomon Islands, make the following regulations.

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prisons (Visiting Contingent) Regulations 2003.

Commencement

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the date of publication in the Gazette.

Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears -

"the Act" means the Prisons Act;

"visiting contingent" has the same meaning as it has in the Facilitation of International Assistance Act 2003.

'visiting prison adviser" means a member of the visiting contingent notified by the assisting country to the Ministry responsible for foreign affairs and providing assistance under the Facilitation of International Assistance Act 2003 in relation to the prison Service.

Certificate of notification

- 4. For the purposes of the administrative command and direction of the Prison Service and the good management and government of prisons, the Superintendent of Prisons may -
- (a) assign to a visiting prison adviser duties and responsibilities; and
- (b) allocate to a visiting prison adviser a nominal prison officer rank.
