THE MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (ENTITLEMENTS) COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Section 69B(2) of the Constitution, the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission hereby makes the following regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission (Amendment) Regulations 2007, and shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 2007.

2. Regulation 4 of the "principal Regulations" is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the definition of the term "on duty" the of regulation following new definitions - 4 of the principal Regulations

"Parliamentary Secretary" means a member of Parliament who is appointed by the Prime Minister to perform a particular Special Duty as and where directed by the Prime Minister;

"Parliamentary Secretary (Rural Development)" means a member of
Parliament who is appointed by the Prime Minister to perform
the following Special Duties within the office of the Prime
Minister in addition to those assigned by the Prime Minister
from time to time, provide strategic political directions necessary
for the implementation of the Rural Development Strategy
(Bottom Up Approach), involving in day to day activities of the
committees, units and arm of government responsible for delivery
of services based on the Strategy, report to Cabinet and Caucus
on the progress of the Strategy and produce reports to Cabinet and
Parliament on the Strategy."

3. Regulation 10A(1) of the principal Regulation is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor -

Repeal and replacement of regulation 10(A)(1)

"Chairman of Caucus and Secretary

10(A). (1) Where a member of Parliament Parliamentary is appointed to the position of Chairman of the of the Parliamentary Caucus and Parlimentary Secretary such Parliamentary person shall be entitled to the same remuneration and entitlements as that of the Deputy Speaker.
