## COMMODITIES EXPORT MARKETING AUTHORITY ACT (Cap. 36)

#### THE COCOA REGULATIONS MANAGEMENT FEES

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 as read with Regulation 18(1) of the Commodities Export Marketing Authority Act, the Minister hereby fix the rate of Management Fee for exporting cocoa. The Rate of fee shall be as follows -

- (a) \$40.00 per tonne for cocoa beans and nibs for export,
- (b) \$8.00 per tonne for residue
- (c) in case of cocoa products \$40.00 per tonne of bean equivalent to those products.

For the purpose of cocoa products, the bean equivalent of the cocoa products is the amount obtained by multiplying the weight of cocoa products by the relevant conversation factors specified herein -

- (a) Cocoa butter 1,33;
- (b) Cocoa cake and Cocoa powder 1,18; and
- (c) Cocoa liquor and Cocoa nibs 1,25

\* The previous management fees are hereby revoked.
