THE FISHERIES (LOCAL FISHING VESSELS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2005

THE FISHERIES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2005

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 25 and 59 of the Fisheries Act, 1998, read with regulation 3 of the Fisheries Regulations 1972, I, PAUL MAENU'U, Minister of Fisheries and Marine Affairs, do hereby make the following regulations -

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Amendment) Regulations 2005, and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the Gazette.
- 2. The Fisheries Regulations are hereby amended by deleting therefrom the Second Schedule and substituting therefor the following new Schedule -
