SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978

THE MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (ENTITLEMENT) COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2007

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 69B(2) of the Constitution, the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission hereby makes the following regulations -

Citation Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission (Amendment) Regulation 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of April 2007.

Insertion of Regulation 10D

2. The principal regulation is hereby amended by inserting immediately after regulation 10C the following new regulation as regulation 10D as follows -

"Local subsistence allowance 10D. All ordinary members of Parliament who travel into Honiara from their Constituencies to to attend a sitting of Parliament shall be paid a local Subsistence allowance at a rate of \$250.00 per day."

Amendment of Appendix A5

3. Appendix A5 of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting therefore the following new Appendix A5 as follows -

Amendment of regulation 9(3)(b)(i)

4. Regulation 9(3)b(i) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the words "seventy five thousand dollars" and inserting therefore the words "eighty thousand dollars".

Amendment of regulation 16(2)

5. Regulation 16(2) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "touring" the words "overseas or".

Amendment of regulation 50(3)

6. Regulation 50(3) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the words "one-fifth of" and inserting immediately after the word "the" the word "full".

Amendment of regulation 31(1)

7. Regulation 31(1) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the figures "\$5,000" and \$10,000" that appear therein and substituting figures "\$9,000" and \$15,000" respectively.

Amendment of regulation 31(3)

8. Regulation 31(3) of the principal regulation is amended by inserting immediately after the word "employ" the words "one security guard".

Amendment of regulation 39(7)

9. Regulation 31(3) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the figure "\$3,000" and \$4,000".

Amendment of regulation 39(8)

10. Regulation 39(8) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the figure "\$1,500" and inserting the figure \$2,000".

Amendment of regulation 40(2)

11. Regulation 40(2) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the figures "\$4,000" and inserting the figure \$2,000" and inserting instead the figures "\$6,000" and \$3,000" respectively

Amendment of regulation 67

12. Regulation 67 of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the words "three to four" and inserting the word "eight".

COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT (Cap. 5)

COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO THE APRIL 2006 CIVIL UNREST IN HONIARA

AMENDMENT OF COMMISSION

BY The Honourable Manasseh D Sogavare MP, Prime Minister of Solomon Islands

TO: MR BRIAN DANESBURY BRUNTON of Alotau, Papua New Guinea; MR WAETA BEN TABUSASI SIM CSI of Honiara, Solomon Islands; MR NOEL LEVI CBE of Kavieng, Papua New Guinea; and MR CHARLES LEVO of Honiara, Solomon Islands

WHEREAS by virtue of the commission* issued on April 24, 2007 Messrs Brian Danesbury Brunton; Waeta Ben Tabusasi SIM CSI; Noel Levi CBE and Charles Levo were duly appointed as commissioners ("the Commissioners") to inquire into the civil unrest which occurred in Honiara during the period between April 18, 2006 and April 20, 2006, following the election of The Honourable Snyder Rini MP as Prime Minister of Solomon Islands ("the April 2006 Civil Unrest") and directed, pursuant to paragraph 3(e) thereof, to submit their written report on the result of their inquiry to the Prime Minister within five months of the commencement of the inquiry.

AND WHEREAS the Prime Minister has considered it advisable to extend the duration of the inquiry by another two months to enable the Commissioners to complete their inquiry

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Prime Minster by Section 4(1) of the Commissions of Inquiry Act (Cap. 5) and pursuant to paragraph 3(e) of the commission*, I, The Honourable Manasseh D Sogavare MP, Prime Minister hereby amend paragraph 3(e) of the commission* by replacing the word "five" with the word "seven"
