CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT

(Cap. 121)

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (IMPORT DUTY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

I, Hon. Harry Kuma, Minister for Finance and Treasury, under section 7 of the *Customs and Excise Act* (Cap. 121), make the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as *Customs and Excise (Import Duty) (Amendment) Order 2023*, and commences on 1 January 2023.

2. Amendment to the First Schedule

This Order amends the First Schedule to the *Customs and Excise Act* (Cap. 121) ("First Schedule").

3. Amendment of duty rates of Mineral Fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes

Section V, Chapter 27 of the First Schedule is amended:

- (a) for tariff items "2710.1211, 2710.1212, 2710.1220, 1210.1230, 2710.1911, 2710.1912", by deleting the duty rate of "\$0.00 per litre" and substituting "\$0.50" per litre;
- (b) for tariff item "2710.1920", by deleting the duty rate of "\$0.00" and substituting "\$0.03" per litre;
- (c) for tariff item "2710.1940", by deleting the duty rate of "0%" per kg and substituting "10%";
- (d) for tariff item "2710.1931", by deleting the duty rate of "\$0.00" per litre, and substituting "\$0.03" per litre;
- (e) for tariff item "2710.1932", by deleting the duty rate of "\$0.00" per litre, and substituting "\$0.20" per litre.

SALES TAX ACT

(Cap. 125)

SALES TAX (PRESCRIBED GOODS AND SERVICES)(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as Sales Tax (Prescribed Goods and Services) (Amendment) Order 2023.

2 Commencement

This Order commences 1 February 2023.

3 Amendment to the Schedule

This Order amends the SCHEDULE to the Act, by inserting after clause 10 of the Schedule the following:

- "12. Sale of Petroleum from any premises Licensed under Petroleum Rules 10 cents per litre
- 13. Sale of diesoline from any premises Licensed under the Petroleum Rules 10 cents per litre".
