## CONSUMPTION TAX ACT 2003 (Section 5(3)(a))

### **ORDER**

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act 2003, the Minister for Revenue and Customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order:

1. With the prior approval of the Chief Executive Officer responsible for fisheries and the Chief Executive Officer for Revenue and Customs, the import of packaging materials for the export of fish and aquaculture shall be exempted from consumption tax.
