

REPUBLIC OF VANUATU

THE IMMIGRATION (EXEMPTION) ORDER No. 8 OF 1990

An Order to exempt certain non-citizens employed by or seconded to the Reserve Bank from the entry permit requirements.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 22A of the Joint Immigration Regulation No. 18 of 1971, as amended, I, WALTER H LINI, Prime Minister and Minister responsible for Immigration, make the following Order:-

**INTERPRETATION**

1. In this Order "Reserve Bank" means the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu established by the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu Act No. 3 of 1980.

**EXEMPTION**

2. (1) Any non-citizens employed by, seconded to or in the service of the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu shall be exempted from the -

- (a) requirements of a visa; or
- (b) requirements of a permit to enter and reside in Vanuatu,

imposed by the Joint Immigration Regulation No. 18 of 1971.


**RESERVE BANK TO INFORM PRINCIPAL IMMIGRATION OFFICER**

3. The Reserve Bank shall, for the purpose of section 1, inform the Principal Immigration Officer, in writing, in good time of any such person referred to in section 1 before that person arrives in Vanuatu.

**COMMENCEMENT**

4. This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.
