CHAPTER 42

LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION OF SALE) ORDER NO.3.2 OF 1995

An order to prohibit the sale and supply of liquor throughout the Republic of Vanuatu in the interest of public peace and good order during the General Elections.

IN EXERCISE of the powers anferre by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP. 52], I, GARLIE N. O., Minister of Home Affairs and Decentralization, hereby make the following order:

SALE OF LIQUOR THROUGHOUT VANUE FU

Subject to section 2, the sale, supply and distribution of alcoholic liquor at, or on, or from Licensed premises throughout the Republic of Vanuat whether for consumption on or off the premises, is hereby probabited from 7.30 AM on Wednesday 29th day of November, 1995 until 7.30 AM Salarday 2nd December, 1995.

EXCEPTION

2. Nothwithstanding the provisions of section 1, alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

COMMENCEMENT

This order shall come into force on 29th November, 1995.
