CHAPTER 20

THE PRISONERS (RELEASE ON LICENCE)
ORDER NO. 6 OF 1994

An Order to provide for the release of Prisoner TOM TARI.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Prisons (Administration) Act [CAP. 20], I, MAXIME CARLOT KORMAN, Prime Minister and Minister responsible for prisons, HEREBY MAKE the following Order :-

RELEASE OF PRISONER ON LICENCE

1. TOM TARI who is currently being held in custody as a prisoner, shall be set free and released from prison on the 4th day of March, 1994 SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS set out in sections 2 and 3 of this Order.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

2. The following terms and conditions shall apply :

- (a) TOM TARI shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour for a period commencing on the day of his release being 4th day of March, 1994 and ending on the 13th day of January, 1996, which period is hereinafter called "the relevant period".
- (b) In the event that TOM TARI should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period, whether or not the offence is of a similar nature as that for which TOM TARI's original prison sentence was ordered by the Court or, the Court before which TOM TARI appears for such new offence orders a prison sentence, TOM TARI shall automatically be recalled and returned to prison.

**PROCEDURES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CONDITIONS OF RELEASE,
RECALL TO PRISON, ETC.**

3. In every case where the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 2 apply, the following procedures shall apply :

- (a) Where the Minister is satisfied that TOM TARI has violated the terms and conditions set out in section 2, the Minister shall issue a Notice in writing directing that TOM TARI is returned to custody forthwith;

- (b) A Notice issued by the Minister shall be served on TOM TARI directing him to return to prison at such time and on such day as specified in the Notice;
- (c) TOM TARI when returned to prison in accordance with this section shall be obliged to serve the unexpired term of his original sentence which he would have had to serve if he had not been released in accordance with this Order;
- (d) TOM TARI when returned to prison in accordance with this section is not entitled to have part of his original unexpired term of sentence remitted.


COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF PRISONS TO ENFORCE DIRECTIONS OF THE MINISTER

4. The Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Prisons shall take all lawful measures required or necessary to enforce every direction or notice issued by the Minister under this Order.

COMMENCEMENT

5. This Order shall come into force on the 4th day of March, 1994.
