CHAPTER 86

PRICE CONTROL (CONSUMER PROTECTION)  
ORDER NO. 17 OF 1995

To protect consumers from being misled by inaccurate retail prices.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by section 16 of the Price Control Act [CAP. 86], I, SERGE VOHOR, Minister of Economic Affairs and Tourism, make the following regulations -

**PROHIBITION OF MISLEADING RETAIL PRICES**

1. No retailer shall sell goods at a retail price higher than that at which he has displayed, offered for sale or advertised such goods (whether such higher price arises from the retailer making provision for the business licence fee on turnover payable by him or otherwise).

**REPEAL**

2. The Price Control (4% Turnover Tax) (Regulations) Order No. 6 of 1995 is repealed.

**COMMENCEMENT**

3. This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.
