Duties and Responsibilities- Principal Environmental Health Officer Order No. 65 of 2014

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILTIES

Duties of the Principal Environmental Health Officer

The Principal Environmental Health Officer has the following duties:

- (a) to inform the Company and the Minister of all communications between the clearance inspections and medical diagnostics; and
- (b) to record, monitor and ensure quality control of all requests for inspection and directives from the Inspection Unit; and
- (c) to monitor medical and diagnostics and advise on quality control of all requests for inspections or directives received; and
- (d) to prepare medical consultation with stakeholders, to draft project plans for national planning in response to health and safety, and
- (e) to consider strategic plans for the Ministry of Health outreach program and other consultation with donor partners; and
- (f) to coordinate all inspection communications with the stakeholders.
