CHAPTER 146

REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (MARK ON THUMB)
ORDER NO. 25 OF 1991

An Order to provide for the placing of an indelible mark on the thumb nail of voters at the general elections to be held on the second day of December, 1991.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 69(1)(c) of the Representation of the People Act [CAP 146], the ELECTORAL COMMISSION hereby makes the following Order:-

PLACING OF INDELIBLE MARK ON VOTERS

1. After each voter has voted, a polling clerk shall place an indelible mark on the thumb nail of the voter, which shall so far as possible be indelible for the period of the poll, before the voter leaves the polling station.


APPLICATION


2. This Order shall apply only to the election declared to take place on the second day of December, 1991, to elect members to Parliament.

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.
