VANUATU TEACHERS UNION
APPOINTMENT OF ADMINISTRATOR
ORDER NO. 46 OF 2006

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by Section 58 of the Trade Unions Act [CAP. 161] ("The Act"), I, the Honourable Willie Jimmy TAPANGARARUA, Minister of Finance and Economic Management do hereby appoint:

Messers Lawrence John Harrison & Kerry John Saunders
of Messers Moores Rowland of Lini Highway, Port Vila, Vanuatu

to act as administrators of Vanuatu Teachers Union ("The Union").

The powers and authority of the said Administrator include:

- (i) Identify and secure all assets of the Union wherever situate
- (ii) Take into custody all books, documents and any Cheque books of the Union
- (iii) Prepare if necessary, the accounts and keep the books and records of matters arising herein
- (iv) Take into custody any identified moveable property of the Union
- (v) Identify all members of the Union
- (vi) Carry on the business of the Union in so far as may be necessary
- (vii) Approve all outgoing payments
- (viii) Counter-sign all cheques
- (ix) May hire and fire any employee
- (x) Report to the Registrar of Trade Unions ("The Registrar") any obstruction to the work of the administrator

- (xi) Prepare monthly written report on the administration process and submit to the Registrar prior to the expiration of each month
- (xii) Include a progressive report with the report mentioned in paragraph ix above
- (xiii) Ensure that any expenses arising out of this administration shall be met by the Union funds
- (xiv) Settle administration costs from the funds of the Union

IN FURTHERANCE THERETO, the Registrar of Trade Unions is hereby empowered to:

- (i) Negotiate remuneration terms with the administrator prior to commencement of any tasks
- (ii) Provide where necessary, a terms of reference for the administrator
- (iii) Issue directions to the Administrator whenever required, on any matters incidental to the administration
- (iv) Receive all reports of the administrator and make further provisions in the premises where appropriate
- (v) Receive and address any queries raised by the administrator
- (vi) Any other functions as deemed appropriate from time to time

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is made and shall exist until revoked.
