VANUATU TEACHERS UNION
REGISTRATION SUSPENSION REGULATION
ORDER NO. 37 OF 2006

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by Section 58 of the Trade Unions Act [CAP. 161] ("The Act"), I, the Honourable Willie Jimmy TAPANGARARUA, Minister of Finance and Economic Management make the following Regulation:

1. Vanuatu Teachers Union ("VTU") (Registration Suspended)

To enable the Registrar of Trade Unions ("The Registrar") to act under Section 13 (3) of the Act being to decide whether or not he should cancel registration of or restore the currently suspended registration of the Vanuatu Teachers Union ("The VTU"),

It is necessary that the Registrar administers and investigates into the affairs of the VTU. The Registrar may do one or all of the following:

- (i) Appoint such person(s) with the necessary qualifications to carry out all and such functions as may be required by the Registrar from time to time while suspension exists,
- (ii) Direct the VTU to settle out of the VTU funds, remunerations of any such appointed person (s)

2. This Regulation commences on the day on which it is made and shall exist until expiration of the suspension order.
