Vanuatu Commodities Marketing Board (Kava) Regulation Order No.100f 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 23 of the Vanuatu Commodities Marketing Board Act [CAP 133], I, the Honourable JAMES BULE Minister of Trade, Commerce, Industry and Tourism make the following Order.

VANUATU COMMODITIES MARKETING BOARD (KAVA) REGULATIONS

An Order to regulate the packaging and marketing of kava.

1 Interpretation

Board means the Vanuatu Commodities Marketing Board as established under section 4 of the Vanuatu Commodities Marketing Board Act [CAP 133];

reconditioning means re-washing, re-drying and repacking kava from a bag which has been found to be in such a condition specified in subclause 3(3).

2 Kava intended for export

All kava intended for export must be contained in good serviceable bags or if presented in bulk, in such form as approved by the Board

3 Bagging of kava for export

)

- (1) A bag containing kava for export must be securely sewn with twine of clean natural fibre in such a manner that there is no opening at the mouth through which kava can escape or be contaminated.
- (2) Each bag containing kava for export must not weigh more than 30 kilograms.
- (3) A bag found to be in a damaged condition or otherwise considered unserviceable by a Board inspector may be withheld and the kava contained in it is to be rejected and returned to the owner for reconditioning.
- (4) Each bag of kava for export must be permanently labelled with a clear and visible marking and inscription that can be read and understood as belonging to the seller and the kava bags are to remain the property of the seller.
- (5) Each bag of kava for export must be permanently labelled with a clear and visible marking and inscription that can be read and understood as containing the 10 varieties of kava, specified in the Schedule, as approved by the Quarantine exporting requirements.

4 Moisture, dust and fungal contents of kava

(1) The Board may not purchase kava if:

- (a) the moisture content of the kava is less than 5%; or
- (b) the dust, dirt and other extraneous matter attached to the kava weighs more than 10% by weight of the kava as determined by passage through a 3/8 inch mesh sieve; or
- (c) the free fatty acid content of extracted oil, expressed as lauric acid, is more than 4 percent.
- (2) Any person offering to sell a kava consignment to the Board is responsible for the costs of reconditioning or disposal of any kava rejected by the Board that is found to contain fungus.

5 Quality and certification of kava

- (1) Subject to subclause 4(1), for the purposes of certifying kava for sale to the Board or for export, a Board inspector may award a certificate to certify the qualities and features of the kava in the following category:
 - (a) Vanuatu stumps;
 - (b) Vanuatu Chips;
 - (c) Vanuatu Roots;
 - (d) Vanuatu Stems.
- (2) For the purposes of facilitating the certification process, an owner presenting his or her kava consignment for certification must separate kava according to the quality and variety of kava.
- (3) A Board inspector shall certify a kava consignment after randomly examining at least 5% of the consignment.

6 Cargo manifests

In addition to the requirements under subclause 3(4), all bagged kava received from a shipping vessel must be accompanied by a cargo manifest in a form approved by the Board.

7 Commencement
