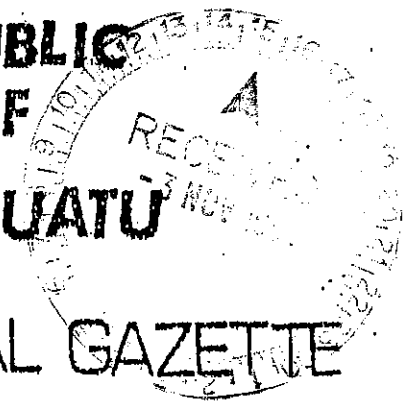

1. Sous réserve des dispositions de l'article 2, il est interdit de vendre, fournir et distribuer des boissons alcoolisées dans ou depuis des établissements autorisés dans les provinces d'Ambae/Maéwo, Malakula et Tongoa/Shepherds pour consommation pendant la période commençant le samedi 23 octobre 1993 à 11h30 et se terminant à 7h30 le mardi 26 octobre 1993.

EXCEPTION

2. Nonobstant les dispositions de l'article 1, les restaurants et hôtels peuvent, au cours de ladite période, pendant leurs heures normales d'ouverture servir aux clients sérieux des boissons alcoolisées à consommer avec leurs repas.

ENTREE EN VIGUEUR

3. Le présent arrêté entrera en vigueur le 23 octobre 1993.

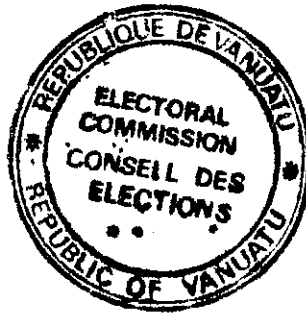

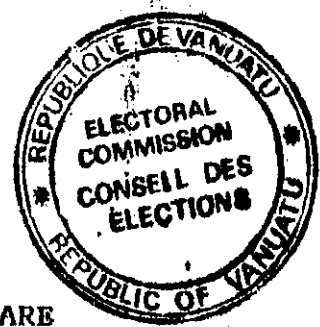

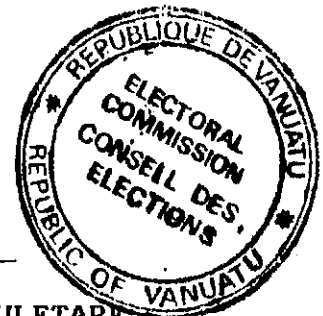

MEMBERS OF ANZ BANK (VANUATU) LIMITED****Scope**

We have audited the financial statements of ANZ Bank (Vanuatu) Limited for the financial year ended 30 September 1993 consisting of the profit and loss account, balance sheet, statement of cash flows and accompanying notes set out on pages 3 to 11. The company's directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain. We have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the company.

Our audit has been conducted in accordance with International Auditing Guidelines to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. Our procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial statements, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with applicable accounting standards and statutory requirements so as to present a view which is consistent with our understanding of the company's financial position and the results of its operations and its cash flows.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.


