THE ISLAND COURTS (POWERS OF MAGISTRATES) ORDER NO. 1 OF 1994

An order to prescribe the powers, functions and duties of a magistrate in respect of matters before an Island Court concerning disputes as to ownership of land.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2A(1) of the Island Courts act No. 10 of 1983(as amended), CAP167, I CHARLES VAUDIN d'IMECOURT, Chief Justice of the Republic of Vanuatu, HEREBY make the following order:-

NOMINATION OF MAGISTRATES TO PRESIDE IN LAND MATTERS

- 1. (1) The Senior Magistrate Mr Selatial Lenalia is hereby nominated to preside over Island Courts on all land matters arising in all areas and districts of Vanuatu.
 - (2) Magistrate Mrs Rita Bill Naviti is hereby nominated to preside over Island Courts on all land matters arising in all areas and districts of the Republic of Vanuatu, save for the Island of Malakula.
 - (3) Furthermore, they shall each perform their powers, functions and duties, pursuant to the Island Courts (Powers of Magistrates) Order No.1 of 1990, as published in the Official Gazette No.1 of 1990.

INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF OBE INSURANCE (VANUATU) LIMITED

Scope

We have audited the financial statements of QBE Insurance (Vanuatu) Limited for the financial year ended 30 June 1994 consisting of the profit and loss account, balance sheet, statement of cash flows and accompanying notes set out on pages 2 to 10. The company's Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain. We have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the company.

- iii) the company's cash flows for the financial year ended on that date.


