- 1. <u>Title</u> These regulations are the Banking (Fees) Regulations 2012.
- Commencement These regulations come into force on 1 March 2012.
- 3. <u>Application fee</u> The application fees payable in accordance with section 6(2)(c) of the Banking Act 2011 are set out in the Schedule.
- 4. Annual licence fee The annual licence fees payable in accordance with sections 6(2)(c) and 13(1) of the Banking Act 2011 are set out in the Schedule.
- 5. Surcharge for late payment of annual licence fee The surcharges payable in accordance with section 13(2) of the Banking Act 2011 are set out in the Schedule.
