1. <u>Title and commencement</u> - (1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amendment (Overtime) Regulations 1992 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959 (N.Z.S.R. 1959/93) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 9th April 1992.

- 2. Overtime (1) Regulation 13(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$15.12" and substituting it with the expression "\$16.33".
- "\$15.12" and substituting it with the expression "\$16.33".

 (2) Regulation 13(1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the expression "\$11.39" and substituting it with the expression "\$12.20".
- 3. <u>Fees for Officer's time</u> Regulations 14(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$7.55" and substituting it with the expression "\$8.15".
