## ORDER

1. Title - This order may be cited as the Minimum Wage Order 1992 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
2. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 18 years and over - The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 18 years and over shall be $\$ 2.53$ per hour.
3. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 16 years and over - The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged between 16 and 18 years shall be $\$ 2.45$ per hour.
4. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged under 16 The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged under 16 years shall be $\$ 2.26$ per hour.
5. Apprenticeship - Every person employed on a contract of Apprenticeship shall be paid in accordance with the relevant rates of pay set out in the schedule to this order.
