Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Island Government (Electoral) Amendment Regulations 2016.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on the day after the date on which they are made.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Island Government (Electoral) Regulations 2014.

4 Regulation 3 is amended


- (1) Regulation 3 is amended by deleting the definition of “Candidate” and substituting the following —

“**candidate** means a person who has been duly nominated for an Island Government election in accordance with the Act.”

- (2) Regulation 3 is amended by repealing the definition of “Citizen”.

5 Part 4 is repealed

Part 4 of the regulations is repealed.
