1. <u>Title</u> (1) This Order may be cited as the Public Holidays (Aitutaki Gospel Day) Order 1989.

2. <u>Aitutaki Gospel Day</u> (1) The public holiday to be known as Aitutaki Gospel Day, shall be on the 27th day of October in each year.

(2) If in any year Aitutaki Gospel Day falls on a Saturday or a Sunday, Aitutaki Gospel Day shall in that year be observed on the following Monday.
