



CHIEF REGISTRAR'S DIRECTIVES TO LEGAL PRACTITIONERS NO.3 OF 2014

In accordance with rule 7.8 of the Rules of Professional Conduct and Practice within the schedule of the Legal Practitioners Decree 2009, I hereby direct that if any legal practitioner operating a law firm wishes to sell or wind up or close down his/her practice should first inform the Chief Registrar's Office in writing of future arrangement for the management of the affairs of existing clients including all client files and also his/her address for service as appropriate.

In accordance with the above, all clients must also be notified within reasonable time of the legal practitioner's intention of selling or winding up or closing down his/her practice. This must be done by public notice.
