KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS PRO-
TECTORATE (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATION, 1908.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western
Pacific under the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of his Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God
of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the
British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith,
Emperor of India.
