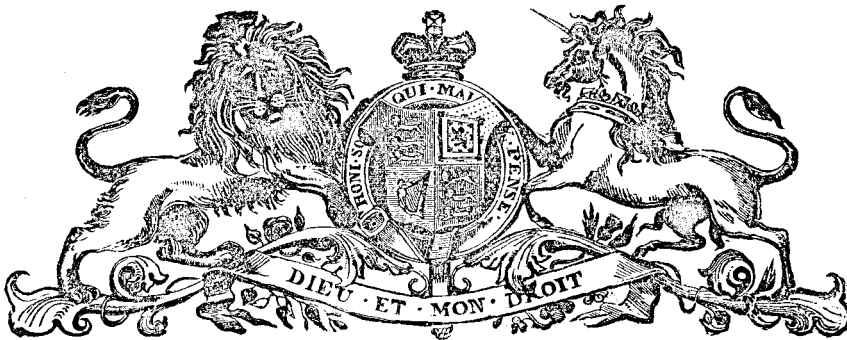

## KING'S REGULATION

*(Made by His Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific, in accordance with the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.)*

TO LEGALISE CERTAIN SALES OF LAND ON OCEAN ISLAND OTHERWISE PAANOPIA.

1. WHEREAS it is expedient to legalise the sale to the Pacific Object of Regula-  
tion. Islands Company Limited of certain parcels of land on Ocean Island otherwise Paanopia by natives of the said Ocean Island on dates subsequent to that of the Proclamation of the High Commissioner for the Western Pacific of the twenty-eighth of November one thousand nine hundred.

2. The sales of land specified in the Schedule hereto shall Sales of land to be  
valid. therefore be held to be as valid and effectual for all purposes as if the terms of the High Commissioner's Proclamation aforesaid and the provisions of section 13 Part III of the Gilberts Regulation 5 of 1893 and of section 14 Part III of the Ellice Regulation 2 of 1894 had not been in force as regards the said Ocean Island otherwise Paanopia at the time such sales were made.

3. This Regulation may be cited as "The Gilbert and Ellice Short title. (Ocean Island) Regulation 1903."
